Families that are selected to purchase a Habitat home must meet the following criteria:

- The family must be working, with a total family income below \$52,000 per year
- There must be young children in the family
- The family must be willing to partner with Habitat for Humanity Saskatoon by contributing a minimum of 500 'sweat equity' hours towards the completion of their home
- They must be prepared to pay an interest-free mortgage

At Habitat's last home-ownership meeting, over 190 hard-working people seeking home ownership attended.

Can you imagine raising a family with a total income of less than \$52,000 per year? To me, it seems nearly impossible without help – particularly with the skyrocketing cost of housing. On average, rent for these families accounts for 60% to 75% of their income, making it near impossible to provide basic necessities. Anything extra such as paying for an extra-curricular activity or saving for post-secondary education for their children is next to impossible.

Habitat homes are built with donations from outstanding community partners. We are asking 100 women in our community donate \$1,000. Together we will raise \$100,000 which is enough to build one brand new Habitat home. Your generous gift will have a positive impact on a Saskatoon family for generations to come. We know after moving into a Habitat home:

- 89% of Habitat homebuyers indicate their family life has improved
- 41% of children improve their grades
- 34% of working parents move on to better-paying jobs
- 23% of parents go back to school
